ABOUT VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Vocational Programs are introduced to promote the idea of learning while working as an alternative to conventional study and trying for a job approach respectively. It supports the central government's objective of enhancing the standard of human resources as a key component of the new education policy introduced by the government. A vocational qualification can be a terrific way to stand out to employers and provides students the practical skills they need to begin climbing the professional ladder as soon as they graduate. Here, the students are not supposed to pursue professional experience at the whim of fate but are followed by the proper knowledge and rare skillset along with placement assistance. The students begin receiving internships/job training in the industry vertical in which they choose to graduate right after orientation.

Dr Mukti Bhatnagar, a dynamic, versatile, charismatic and multidimensional personality was a Professor of Medicine and a teacher of high acclaim and repute. She completed her graduation (MBBS) and post graduation (MD in General Medicine) from M.L.N. College, Allahabad. According to Letter No. D.O.No.F.2-7/2014 (CC/NVEQF)/ Misc. Dated on August 3, 2016:

- (1) Bachelor of Vocation (B. Voc.), a Bachelor level degree specified by UGC under section 22(3) of UGC Act, 1956 and notified in the official Gazette of India dated January 19, 2013 be recognized at par with the other Bachelor level degrees for competitive exams conducted by Union/State Public Service Commission, Staff Selection Commission or other such bodies where the eligibility criteria are "Bachelor Degree in any discipline".
- (2) Students with B.Voc. Degrees should be considered eligible for the trans-disciplinary vertical mobility into such courses where the entry qualification is Bachelor's Degree without specific requirements in a particular discipline.


"Skill-based education should be the foundation of modern education", with a similar view, the University Grants Commission (UGC), in 2013, introduced the Bachelor of Vocational, commonly known as B.Voc degree program with multiple entry and exit points. B.Voc is a three-year program that specifically focuses on skill development and make the students industry-ready. Today, there are more than 100 disciplines/trades for which the B.Voc degree courses are available. Some of the most popular courses include B.Voc in Retail Marketing, Food Processing, Healthcare, Technology, and Renewable Energy.

The General Education Components (GEC) and Skill Education Components (SEC) would be appropriately balanced in each semester/year of the program's curriculum at a predetermined ratio of 40:60.

Overall Credits - A degree can be completed in three years with 180 credits, or 30 credits every semester.

DURATION OF THE COURSE •

The duration of this bachelor course will be 3 years i.e., 6 semesters with the flexibility of exit after completion of 2nd & 4th semesters. On the other hand, the duration of the master's will be of 2 years in
